

Coach your students during The UN2023 Gamechanger Challenge!

Are you curious how you can achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) together you're your students? Keep reading!

Wavemakers United and IHE Delft Institute for Water Education have developed a Challenge that stimulates young people to come up with an innovative and implementable idea that contributes to the global water challenges. In this way, students and pupils can contribute to a climate resilient future.

The Challenge goes: "Develop an innovative and implementable idea that takes on global water challenges and ensures a climate resilient future."

The top five ideas will be pitched in New York at the UN2023 Water Conference in March 2023!

How does it work?

Students will deliver the idea in a team of 2-6 people, inspired by the guest lesson given to a local community. This can be a primary/secondary/music school or even a sports club/foundation. So yes, you!

The student gives a guest lecture about the SDGs and the next generation learns about water and sustainability. In addition, the students are challenged to come up with a solution regarding the global water challenges. Children think less in terms of limitations and therefore the outcome might be a great out of the box idea! The student will take the idea to further develop. A real win-win!

How can I participate as a primary or secondary school?

1. Find a student who is enrolled in a university or knowledge institute.
2. Make an appointment with the student for a guest lesson.
3. Enjoy the guest lecture and challenge the children to innovate!
4. The student keeps the school informed of the progress
5. Will your idea be in the top 5? Big chance that your idea will actually be implemented by external companies!
